A New Generation of Opioids

Drugs.com Definition:

"Gray Death is reported to be an illicit opioid combination of powerful and dangerous drugs that have led to several fatal overdoses in the U.S. The designer, synthetic combo drug is said to be many more times potent than heroin."

Composition:

Gray Death is reportedly a combination of heroine, fentanyl, carfentanil, U-47700, methamphetamine, and even tranquilizers for large animals such as elephants.

Best Practices:

- **Universal Precautions**
 - Wear gloves if you see drugs that you suspect to be gray death or other opioids
 - Don't open or test drugs that you suspect are gray death or other opioids
 - Be careful and aware at all times!
- **Narcan**
 - Keep a good supply of Narcan available
 - Bear in mind that gray death and other opioids are becoming stronger and stronger so more doses of Narcan are necessary to revive those who overdose from drug use or exposure
