Dear Congressman Banks:

On behalf of the International Union of Police Associations, I am writing to give our support and endorsement for your recently introduced legislation, H.R. 233., to amend the revised statute to codify the defense of qualified immunity in the case of any action under section 1979.

The I.U.P.A. represents rank and file law enforcement professionals across this great nation, including the territories of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Law enforcement officers make critical life and death decisions daily in conditions that do not give them the luxury that those who later evaluate those decisions are afforded.
